

OFFICIAL RULES

DALLAS SPORTS COMMISSION BIG DREAMS CONTEST

NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT OF ANY KIND IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. A PURCHASE DOES NOT IMPROVE THE CHANCES OF WINNING.

THIS CONTEST IS INTENDED FOR PLAY IN THE STATE OF TEXAS ONLY AND WILL BE GOVERNED BY TEXAS LAW. DO NOT ENTER IF YOU DO NOT MEET CRITERIA SPECIFIED BELOW, AND/OR ARE NOT ELIGIBLE AT TIME OF ENTRY. VOID IN ALL OTHER STATES OR COMMONWEALTH OF THE UNITED STATES, PUERTO RICO, UNITED STATES POSSESSIONS AND TERRITORIES, AND WHERE PROHIBITED OR RESTRICTED BY LAW.

The Dallas Sports Commission Big Dreams Contest (“Contest”) is subject to these Official Rules (“Rules”) and to all applicable federal, state, and local laws. By participating, you agree to be fully and unconditionally bound by these Rules and you represent and warrant that you meet the eligibility requirements set forth herein. You agree to accept all decisions made by Sponsor related to the Contest as final and binding.

1. Sponsor. The Dallas Convention & Visitors Bureau d/b/a Dallas Sports Commission (“Dallas Sports Commission”), 1807 Ross Avenue, Suite 450, Dallas, TX 75201.

2. Administrators. Dallas Sports Commission and ActiveCampaign, LLC, 1 North Dearborn Street, 5th Floor, Chicago, IL 60602.

2. Eligibility. This Contest is open to legal United States residents of the City of Dallas only who are:

- (a) at least 18 years of age as of June 23, 2026, and
- (b) are the parent or legal guardian of a minor child between the ages of 12 and 17 as of the date of entry and such minor child is a legal resident of the City of Dallas, and
- (c) the parent or legal guardian is a verified registrant in the Mayor’s Youth Sports Ticket Program as of the date the entry in the Contest is submitted.

You may register for the Mayor’s Youth Sports Ticket Program by going to <https://www.dallassports.org/mayors-youth-ticket-program/> and completing and submitting the registration form. No purchase or payment is required to register for the Mayor’s Youth Sports Ticket Program.

Employees of Sponsor, Administrators, prize providers, advertising and promotional partners and agencies, their affiliates, parent companies, and subsidiaries of any of them (the “Contest Entities”), together with the immediate families (spouses, parents, siblings, and children) and those persons living in the same household as such employees (whether or not related), are not eligible to enter or win. **Residents of any other states or commonwealths of the United States, Puerto Rico, United States Possessions and Territories, or any state where prohibited or restricted by law are not eligible to participate or win.**

3. Promotion Period. The promotion period (“Promotion Period”) will begin on June 23, 2026, at 9:30 a.m. Central Time (“CT”) and will end at 11:59 p.m. CT on July 5, 2026. Sponsor’s or Administrators’ (or their designated representative’s) computer is the official timekeeper for the Contest.

4. How to Enter. During the Promotion Period,

- (a) visit www.dallassports.org/mayors-youth-ticket-program/; and
- (b) enter the required information in the entry form including without limitation first name, last name, email address, telephone number, zip code of your legal address, year of birth, and an essay not to exceed 500

words in length explaining why the entrant's minor child enjoys participating in or watching sports, how sports has positively impacted them, and how their passion for sports will set them up for success later in life; and

(c) upload a photograph ("Photograph") of entrant and entrant's minor child at any type of sporting event; and

(d) submit the entry form.

THE EMAIL ADDRESS SUBMITTED WITH THE ENTRY FORM MUST MATCH THE EMAIL ADDRESS ASSOCIATED WITH THE ENTRANT'S REGISTRATION IN THE MAYOR'S YOUTH SPORTS TICKET PROGRAM.

During the entry process, entrants may be given the opportunity to opt in to receive commercial or promotional emails or texts from Contest Entities but are not required to do so. Opting in to receive commercial or promotional communications will not increase an entrant's chance of winning. **Limit one entry per person during the Promotional Period please.**

The essay ("Essay") should not exceed 500 words, but Essays submitted with more than 500 words will not be automatically disqualified but Sponsor will only be obligated to read and consider up to the first 500 words. Essays need not be truthful. Sponsor will not verify the truthfulness of the information submitted in each entry; provided, however, that failure to satisfy the entry eligibility requirements or other Rules applicable to this Contest can result in disqualification of the entrant from becoming the Winner, in the Sponsors sole and absolute discretion. Sponsor reserves the right, but is under no obligation, to edit an entrants Essay in any manner that it chooses in Sponsors sole and absolute discretion.

Photograph must be uploaded in either the ".jpeg" or ".png" file format (no other formats will be accepted). The terms "Photograph", "Photo", and/or "Image" may be used interchangeably. **ONLY THE ENTRANT AND ENTRANT'S MINOR CHILD MAY BE CAPTURED IN THE PHOTO. NO OTHER PERSON'S IMAGE, VOICE, TALENT, AND/OR INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY (i.e., trademark(s), and/or copyrighted photo(s), Photo(s), song(s), works of art, etc.) CAN BE CAPTURED IN THE PHOTO (no matter how far away, obscure, or otherwise). ANY PHOTO WITH ANY OTHER PERSON(S), INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY DEPICTED IN IT WILL BE INELIGIBLE AND DISQUALIFIED.** Sponsor's decision in this matter is final and not appealable, and Sponsor is not obligated to treat every entry identically.

Entrant must exclusively own the submitted Essay and Photo (i.e., Photo and Essay cannot be "owned" in any way by any other person or company without obtaining his/her express consent to enter this Contest and allow Sponsor to use the Photo and Essay as contemplated in these Rules). The Essay and Photo must not contain or convey any content that the Sponsor determines, at its sole discretion, subjectively or otherwise, (i) to be indecent, profane, obscene, explicitly sexual, harmful, threatening, abusive, harassing, tortious, defamatory, vulgar, libelous, or hateful, (ii) to be racially, ethnically, or otherwise offensive or objectionable, (iii) to encourage unlawful behavior, (iv) to infringe upon the brand names, trademarks, trade names, logos, or any other intellectual property that may belong to a third party, or (v) to disclose any detailed personal, physical, contact, or otherwise confidential information that may belong to a third party. The foregoing is not intended to require Sponsor to disqualify Entrants who, in Sponsor's sole discretion, appear to be innocently wearing clothing or are in areas that just happen to contain third party logos or marks. Further, Sponsor may but is not obligated to pixelate/cover any trademarks/servicemarks and/or copyrighted materials in Sponsor's sole discretion. Sponsor will not be required to make the same determination based on the foregoing for every Photo or Essay and may treat all Photos and Essays differently, at its sole discretion, even if the problematic Photos or Essays are similar.

SPONSOR RESERVES THE RIGHT, BUT NOT THE OBLIGATION TO POST ENTRY INFORMATION, ESSAYS, AND/OR PHOTOS ON THE SPONSOR'S WEBSITE, SOCIAL NETWORKING SITES, OR OTHER PLATFORMS, IN WHOLE, IN PART, OR IN AN EDITED FORM IN SPONSOR'S SOLE DISCRETION. POSTING OF ENTRY INFORMATION, ESSAY, OR PHOTO DOES NOT MEAN THAT THE ENTRANT HAS WON OR IS LIKELY TO WIN. THE DECISION TO POST ANY SUCH ENTRIES OR PHOTOS IS FOR ENTERTAINMENT AND PROMOTIONAL PURPOSES ONLY AND IS NOT PART

OF THE WINNER SELECTION PROCESS.

In the event of a dispute over the identity of an entrant, the authorized account holder of the email address or mobile phone number provided at the time of entry will be deemed to be the entrant. The authorized account holder of an email address is the natural person assigned to such account by the Internet access provider, online service provider, or other organization responsible for assigning email addresses for the domain associated with such account. The authorized account holder of a mobile phone account is the natural person reflected in the provider's records as registering the account. The potential winner may be required to provide identification sufficient to show that s/he was the authorized account holder of such email address or phone number.

All entries become the property of Sponsor and will not be acknowledged or returned to entrant. Automated and/or repetitive electronic submission of entries (including but not limited to entries made using any script, macro, bot, or Contest service) will be disqualified and transmissions from these or related phone numbers, email addresses, and/or IP addresses may be blocked. Use of multiple accounts to enter will result in disqualification. All entries must be received and recorded during the Promotion Period to be eligible for the drawing. Proof of entry is not proof of receipt.

5. Prizes. Up to one (1) prize ("Prize"). The Prize consists of the items specifically identified below:

- Two (2) courtside seat tickets for the winner and their minor child to attend the July 12, 2026 Dallas Wings game versus Chicago at the American Airlines Center (Approximate Retail Value ("ARV") per ticket is \$750.00 and the ARV for both tickets is \$1,500.00);
- One (1) parking pass for the American Airlines Center for the July 12, 2026 Dallas Wings game (ARV \$40.00)

The total ARV of the Prize for the Contest is \$1,540.00.

By accepting the Prize, winner acknowledges, agrees, and consents, on behalf of themselves and on behalf of their minor child, that Sponsor and/or its representatives may accompany winner and their minor child at the Dallas Wings game, record, photograph, and/or videotape winner and their minor child's experience at the American Airlines Center, and to use such content for all lawful purposes as more fully set forth in these Rules.

Tickets included in the Prize are electronic. Redeeming and using the Prize tickets requires for the winner (i) to have a valid email address and an app-enabled mobile device capable of downloading and running a third-party mobile ticketing app (e.g., Ticketmaster, AXS, etc.); (ii) to install, or have already installed, such mobile ticketing app on their app-enabled mobile device; and (iii) to login into an existing user account or to sign up for a free user account with the third-party operating such mobile ticketing app by completing a form with all required information, including at a minimum first name, last name, and valid email address. **THE TICKET PRIZE(S) IN THIS CONTEST CANNOT BE REDEEMED OR USED BY ANY MEANS OTHER THAN THE DESIGNATED THIRD-PARTY MOBILE TICKETING APP(S) FOR THIS PRIZE. INDIVIDUALS WHO DO NOT HAVE A VALID EMAIL ADDRESS, ACCESS TO AN APP-ENABLED MOBILE DEVICE AND/OR DO NOT COMPLY WITH THE FOREGOING REQUIREMENTS WILL NOT BE ABLE TO REDEEM OR USE THE TICKET PRIZE(S) IN THIS SWEEPSTAKES SHOULD THEY BE SELECTED AND VERIFIED AS A WINNER, WILL NOT RECEIVE A SUBSTITUTE PRIZE, AND SHOULD NOT ENTER THIS CONTEST.**

Any difference between the actual retail value of a Prize and the approximate retail value stated in these Rules will not be awarded. Winners are responsible for all other expenses associated with receipt and use of a Prize (other than delivery to winner's shipping address, if applicable). Sponsor will ship the Prize (if applicable) at Sponsor's expense to winner(s) at the legal address provided by the winner(s). Winners are responsible for ensuring the legal address information of the winner is correct. The prize is limited to the item specified above and winner(s) are responsible for all other expenses associated with receipt and use of a Prize (other than delivery to winner's shipping address, if applicable).

Prizes are considered compensation to the winner. All federal, state, municipal and local taxes associated with receipt or use of a Prize are the sole responsibility of winner. Sponsor will file an IRS Form 1099 for the value of the Prize if legally required to do so, and in that instance the winner will be required to furnish his or her social security number

and complete and return an IRS W-9 form for purposes of same, as more fully set forth in these Rules.

There is no cash award associated with the Prize. The Prize is not transferable. No substitutions or exchanges by winner permitted. Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to substitute a prize or one or more elements of the Prize for a prize of equal or greater value. Prize may not be redeemed for cash value.

6. Transportation, Expenses, and Tickets. THE PRIZE DOES NOT INCLUDE TRAVEL AND WINNER AND GUESTS ARE SOLELY RESPONSIBLE FOR TRAVEL TO AND FROM ALL PRIZE EVENTS. UNLESS OTHERWISE EXPRESSLY PROVIDED FOR IN THESE RULES, WINNER IS RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL EXPENSES IN CONNECTION WITH RECEIPT AND USE OF THE PRIZE, INCLUDING WITHOUT LIMITATION, GROUND TRANSPORTATION, FOOD AND BEVERAGES, CONCESSIONS, AND ANY OTHER COSTS.

SPONSOR IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR WINNERS INABILITY TO USE OR REDEEM ANY PRIZE TICKETS FOR ANY REASON.

Winner and winner's guest(s) are solely responsible for compliance with all event and venue entry requirements, restrictions related to pandemic or epidemic disease, or other related requirements or restrictions. Sponsor is not responsible for forfeiture of any Prize or any element thereof due to winner or guest's failure to comply with any security, entry, pandemic or epidemic disease, or similar requirements. Deadlines for redemption and/or use of any vouchers, passes, tickets, certificates, etc. are final and not subject to modification. The winner and their guest(s) hereby agree that they will observe all rules and regulations of any venue, or other prize provider or prize related entity related to Prize redemption. Sponsor shall have no responsibility or liability for cancellations, delays, or any other change by any company or person providing any element of a Prize and is not responsible or liable for any expenses incurred as a consequence thereof. Winner(s) and any permitted guest(s) specifically release Sponsor from all claims for loss or damage to property, or from personal injuries or death, or from loss or delay, arising out of the acts, omissions, or negligence of any providers of services or facilities. If a Prize includes one or more guests and winner chooses not to include the allotted guest(s) or winner's guest(s) fails to provide applicable affidavits and/or releases, all elements of the Prize associated with such guest(s) shall be forfeited, in which event winner's receipt of the remaining elements of the Prize shall constitute full satisfaction of Sponsor's Prize obligation to winner and no additional compensation will be awarded or provided to winner.

8. Winner Selection, Notification, and Verification. One (1) potential winner will be selected by a panel of three (3) judges selected by Sponsor in its sole discretion. The judges will review all eligible Essays received during the Promotion Period based on any lawful criteria which may, but is not required to, include the substance of the essay and the specificity of the Essay in addressing the themes set out in Section 4 of these rules. Each judge will assign a score to each Essay between one (1) and five (5) points (5 being the highest score and 1 being the lowest score). The maximum possible total score for each Essay is 15 points. The Entrant whose Essay has the highest total point score will be deemed the potential winner, subject to verification of eligibility. In the event two or more Essays are tied for the highest score, each judge will vote on which of the tied Essays they believe is the best Essay and the Essay that receives the most votes will be deemed the potential winner, subject to verification of eligibility. In the event two or more Essays tie for the most votes, a second vote will be taken from among those Essays and the Essay with the most votes will be deemed the winner, subject to verification of eligibility. The scoring, voting, and/or decisions of the judges are final and not subject to appeal.

The selected potential winner will be assigned the Prize identified in Section 5 of these Rules by Sponsor in its sole discretion. Sponsor will contact the potential winner via phone or email, at Sponsor's sole discretion. If a potential winner does not respond within TWENTY-FOUR (24) HOURS of notification attempt, or a notification is returned as undeliverable, that potential winner will be disqualified and, subject to the following paragraph, an alternate potential winner may be selected based on the next highest total point score, or in the event of a tie the next highest vote total from among the tied Essays, as more fully described in the paragraph above. Notification is deemed to have occurred immediately at the time Sponsor calls or transmits an email. Sponsor will only be required to attempt to leave one voicemail message or send one email. Sponsor reserves the right, but not the obligation, to attempt to contact any winner(s) more than once, in its sole and absolute discretion, and will not be required to attempt to contact

potential winner(s) an equal number of times or in the same manner. Sponsor is not responsible for any change of email address and/or telephone number of any entrant(s) and/or winner(s).

If a potential winner cannot be contacted, is found to be ineligible, does not or cannot comply with these Official Rules, or fails to timely return any required documents specified in these Rules, the potential winner will be disqualified, the Prize will be forfeited, and an alternate potential winner may be selected. If Sponsor is unable to successfully identify a qualified potential winner after Sponsor has attempted to notify two (2) potential winners, or if Sponsor determines in its sole discretion that a potential winner cannot be identified sufficiently in advance of the Prize event, Sponsor may elect to not to award the Prize.

Potential winners are subject to verification, including verification of residence. In order to receive a Prize, winner may be required, within the time period designated by Sponsor, to (a) present a valid photo identification issued by the State of Texas or by the United States federal government; (b) complete, sign, and return to Sponsor an affidavit of eligibility and liability release; (c) except where prohibited by law, complete, sign, and return a publicity release; and/or (d) complete and submit an IRS Form W-9 in its entirety, which includes the winner's valid United States taxpayer identification number or social security number.

No entrant or potential winner is a winner of a Prize unless and until an entrant's eligibility has been verified and Sponsor has confirmed such verification to the winner, even if that entrant's name has been publicly posted or identified as a winner prior to completion of the verification process.

9. General.

a. THIS CONTEST IS SUBJECT TO ALL APPLICABLE FEDERAL, STATE, MUNICIPAL, AND LOCAL LAWS AND REGULATIONS.

b. Sponsor has not made and is not responsible for, and hereby disclaims, any representation, warranty, or guaranty, express or implied, in fact or in law, relative to the Prize.

c. By participating in this Contest, entrant agrees to abide by and be bound by these Official Rules, and to waive any right to claim any ambiguity or error herein or in the Contest itself, and to be bound by all actions of the Sponsor and/or Sponsor's representative, whose decisions are binding and final on all matters related to this Contest.

d. Any normal Internet access and usage charges imposed by your Internet service provider will apply. If you use a mobile device to access the Contest entry form, your wireless service carrier's standard charges, data rates, and other fees may apply. You understand that by participating in this Contest, if you are a potential winner, the Sponsor may contact you via mobile phone, which may be subject to charges pursuant to your carrier's rate plan.

e. To the maximum extent permitted by law, by participating in the Contest or accepting a Prize, entrant and/or winner(s) grants to Sponsor, its parent, subsidiaries, affiliates, licensees, successors, and assigns, and those acting under their authority to use, and to authorize others to (a) interview the entrant and/or winner(s) (and winner's guest(s), if applicable), (b) photograph, film, and record (by means of audio, video, photography, or otherwise) entrant and/or winner(s) (and winner's guest(s), if applicable), (c) use in commerce entrant or winner(s)'s name, likeness, biographical information, entry materials including Photo and Essay, prize information (if any), and/or any statements made by them regarding the Sponsor, the Contest, and/or any Contest Entities throughout the world in all media now known or hereafter existing and in perpetuity for any lawful purpose (including but not limited to advertising, marketing, publicity, and promotion of Sponsor, the Contest Entities, the Contest, other Sponsor promotions, the products and services associated with Sponsor and the Contest, and for all their internal business purposes) without further compensation, permission, notification, or right of approval.

To the maximum extent permitted by law, by participating in this Contest and/or accepting any Prize, each entrant agrees for themselves and their minor child, and for their heirs, executors, and administrators to release, hold harmless, indemnify, and defend Sponsor, the Contest Entities, and their respective officers, directors, employees, and representatives from and against any and all liability for any loss, harm, damages, right, claims, costs, or expenses (including attorney fees), including without limitation property damages, personal injury and/or death, in connection with or arising out of participation in this Contest; the delivery, acceptance, possession, or use or misuse of any Prize;

preparing for, participating in, and/or traveling to or from any Prize-related activity; and/or any claims based on rights of publicity, rights of privacy, or defamation.

g. By entering this Contest, entrant understands and agrees that all rights under Section 1542 of the Civil Code of California (“Section 1542”) and any similar law of any state or territory of the United States that may be applicable with respect to the foregoing release are hereby expressly and forever waived. You understand and acknowledge that Section 1542 states: “A GENERAL RELEASE DOES NOT EXTEND TO CLAIMS THAT THE CREDITOR OR RELEASING PARTY DOES NOT KNOW OR SUSPECT TO EXIST IN HIS OR HER FAVOR AT THE TIME OF EXECUTING THE RELEASE AND THAT, IF KNOWN BY HIM OR HER MUST HAVE MATERIALLY AFFECTED HIS OR HER SETTLEMENT WITH THE DEBTOR OR RELEASED PARTY.” By participating in this Contest, entrant expressly waives and relinquishes all rights and benefits under that section and any law of any jurisdiction of similar effect with respect to her or his release of any claims he or she may have against Sponsor as a result of participation in the Contest or acceptance of a Prize.

h. Sponsor assumes no responsibility or liability for (i) any incorrect or inaccurate registration or entry information, or for any faulty, failed, garbled, or jumbled electronic data transmissions; (ii) any unauthorized access to, or theft, destruction, or alteration of entries at any point in the operation of this Contest; (iii) any technical malfunction, failure, error, omission, interruption, deletion, defect, delay in operation, or communications line failure, regardless of cause, with regard to any equipment, systems, networks, lines, satellites, servers, computers, or providers utilized in any aspect of the operation of the Contest; (iv) inaccessibility or unavailability of the Internet in general; or (v) any injury or damage to participant’s or to any other person’s computer or mobile device which may be related to or result from any attempt to participate in the Contest.

i. Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to modify, cancel, or suspend this Contest (or any portion of the Contest) should any cause or problem corrupt or inhibit the administration, fairness, security, or proper operation of the Contest and, in such situation, to select the winner in a manner deemed fair and appropriate by Sponsor. If, in the Sponsor’s opinion, there is any suspected or actual evidence of tampering with any portion of the Contest, or if technical difficulties compromise the integrity of the Contest, Sponsor reserves the right to void suspect entries and/or terminate the Contest (or any portion of the Contest) and, if feasible as determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion, select a winner or winners using all known eligible non-suspect entries received as of the date of termination, or to not select any winners. Sponsor may prohibit entrant from participating in the Contest or winning a Prize if, in its sole discretion, it determines entrant is attempting to undermine the legitimate operation of the Contest by cheating, deception, or other unfair practices or intending to annoy, abuse, threaten, or harass any other entrant or Sponsor’s representatives. Any attempt by an entrant to deliberately undermine the legitimate operation of the Contest is a violation of criminal and civil laws, and should such an attempt be made, Sponsor reserves the right to seek damages from any such entrant to the fullest extent permitted by law. Sponsor is not responsible for typographic or printer’s errors. In no event will more than the number of Prizes stated in these Official Rules be awarded.

j. WAIVER. BY PARTICIPATING IN THIS SWEEPSTAKES, ENTRANTS AGREE ON BEHALF OF THEMSELVES AND THEIR MINOR CHILD THAT, TO THE EXTENT PERMITTED BY APPLICABLE LAW, (A) ANY AND ALL DISPUTES, CLAIMS, AND CAUSES OF ACTION ARISING OUT OF OR CONNECTED WITH THE SWEEPSTAKES, OR ANY PRIZES OR OFFERS AWARDED, SHALL BE RESOLVED INDIVIDUALLY, WITHOUT RESORT TO ANY FORM OF CLASS ACTION; (B) ANY AND ALL CLAIMS, JUDGMENTS, AND AWARDS SHALL BE LIMITED TO ACTUAL OUT-OF-POCKET COSTS INCURRED, INCLUDING COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH ENTERING THE SWEEPSTAKES, BUT IN NO EVENT WILL ATTORNEY’S FEES BE AWARDED OR RECOVERABLE; AND (C) UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES WILL ANY ENTRANT BE PERMITTED TO OBTAIN ANY AWARD FOR, AND ENTRANT HEREBY KNOWINGLY AND EXPRESSLY WAIVES ALL RIGHTS TO SEEK PUNITIVE, INCIDENTAL, OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES, AND/OR ANY OTHER DAMAGES (OTHER THAN ACTUAL OUT-OF-POCKET EXPENSES), AND/OR ANY AND ALL RIGHTS TO HAVE DAMAGES MULTIPLIED OR OTHERWISE INCREASED. SOME JURISDICTIONS DO NOT ALLOW CERTAIN LIMITATIONS OR EXCLUSION OF LIABILITY, SO THE FOREGOING MAY NOT APPLY TO EVERY ENTRANT.

k. Governing Law. This Contest shall be governed by the laws of the State of Texas, without regard to conflicts of laws provisions. Venue for any actions hereunder shall be the appropriate state or federal courts located in the city and county of Dallas, Texas.

l. Use of Information.
