With two major airports providing daily direct flights from more than 300 destinations, Dallas is within four hours by air from almost anywhere in the country. Plus, the robust number of non-stop flights originating in Dallas offers travelers options and convenience.



DALLAS/FORT WORTH INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (DFW)

FAST FACTS

- 20 miles to Downtown Dallas

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION | DART

- Light rail to Downtown Dallas: approximately one hour
- Cost: \$3/single-ride pass, \$6/day pass
- Operating 4 - 1 a.m. daily

GROUND TRANSPORTATION

- Approximate taxi cost to Downtown Dallas: \$57
- Approximate shuttle cost to Downtown Dallas: \$58 per person
- Approximate ride sharing cost to Downtown Dallas: \$45

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION | DART

- DART's Love Link 524 operates between Dallas Love Field and Inwood/Love Field Station, providing an airport connection to the DART Green Line and Orange Line.
- Light rail to Downtown Dallas: less than 15 minutes
- Cost: \$3/single-ride pass, \$6/day pass
- Operating 4 - 1 a.m. daily

GROUND TRANSPORTATION

- Approximate taxi cost to Downtown Dallas: \$15
- Approximate shuttle cost to Downtown Dallas: \$35 per person
- Approximate ride sharing cost to Downtown Dallas: \$15
